Demolition Permit Information

Recorded plat of the property

- Copy of contract with demolition and/or disposal company.
- For individual removing without use of company a receipt from disposal location will be required.
- A 911 address or the closest location to site.
- Permit Valid for **30** days, unless otherwise specified by Code Enforcement.
- One (1) inspection required.
- All inspections are by request only. **One day's notice is required.** When calling for an inspection, please give permit number and permit holders name.
- Any special restrictions placed by Code Enforcement or Building Inspector.
- **Note: All state and federal regulations for removal and disposal must be met.**
- Post the **permit card** at entrance to the job site. The inspector signs the card on each visit. If the inspector finds work that must be corrected, he will leave a list of the items near the permit card.
- All inspections are by request only. **One day's notice** is required. When calling for an inspection, please give the permit number and permit holders name. If an inspection requires the inspector to pass through a locked door or gate, you may leave the door or gate unlocked, or hide a key. If the inspector cannot gain entry for the inspection, a **\$50.00 re-inspect fee** will apply.
- If you must cancel an inspection, please call by **8:30am** the morning of the inspection or a **\$50.00 re-inspect fee** will apply.
- Building inspectors are in the office and available to answer questions at the following times:
Monday – Friday 8:00 AM to 9:30 AM
- Permits are issued between 8:00 am and 4:30 pm Monday through Friday
