The public is hereby notified that the Board of Commissioners of Madison County, Georgia has scheduled a determination of the issue the following portion of County Road 306, also known as Osley Mill Road and described as follows, has ceased to be used by the public to the extent that no substantial public purpose is served by it or that its removal from the county road system is otherwise in the best public interest:

Commencing at the northerly boundary of the “Gravel Drive” as shown on that survey entitled “Survey for Magnify Credit Union, Denver A. Phares, The Graham Law Firm, LLC, and Chicago Title Insurance Company,” revised January 4, 2011, by G. Brian Slate, Ga. Registered land Surveyor No. 2629, recorded in Plat Book B234, page, 1A, of the records of the Clerk of Superior Court of Madison County, Georgia, which survey and the recording thereof are specifically incorporated herein by reference; and running in a general southerly and easterly direction to a point identified as Point “R-2” on the right-of-way of Osley Mill Road as shown on that that survey entitled “Survey for Danny and Cindy Colquitt,” revised August 24, 2004, by David L. Ringo, Ga. Registered land Surveyor No. 2250, recorded in Plat Book B125, page, 8B, of the records of the Clerk of Superior Court of Madison County, Georgia, which survey and the recording thereof are specifically incorporated herein by reference.

A public hearing by the Board of Commissioners of Madison County on the issue of abandonment of such roadway shall be held at 6:00 P.M. on January 31, 2022, in the public meeting room of the Madison County Courthouse. All interested persons are hereby notified of their right to appear and be heard at said public hearing.
