

**RESOLUTION AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE
OF MADISON COUNTY, GEORGIA**

For the purpose of promoting the health, safety, and general welfare of the present and future inhabitants of Madison County and to further the purposes of the Madison County Zoning Ordinance as set forth therein, the Board of Commissioners of Madison County does hereby ordain and enact into law the following changes to the Madison County Zoning Classification.

Add:

Section 7.9.1.13

All permitted Business Uses allowed under Section 7.7.1 will be a permitted use in an Industrial zone.

If more than two (2) businesses are to be located on the same lot, the application must receive written approval from the Board of Commissioners following review and recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission.

Add:

Under Article VII (Chart)

All permitted Business Uses allowed under Section 7.7.1 will be a permitted use in an Industrial zone. Change telecommunication towers from conditional use to Permitted Use.

The provisions of this resolution shall be effective upon approval by the Madison County Board of Commissioners.
