

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING  
ORDINANCE OF MADISON COUNTY, GEORGIA.**

For the purpose of promoting the health, safety, and general welfare of the present and future inhabitants of Madison County and to further the purposes of the Madison County Zoning Ordinance as set forth therein, the Board of Commissioners of Madison County does hereby ordain and enact into law the following changes to the Madison County Zoning Ordinance.

**ITEM ONE.**

A subsection 14.2.4.16 is added to Article 14, reading as follows:  
"14.2.4.16 The written analysis shall address each of the zoning amendment criteria set forth in Section 14.3.9 hereof."

**ITEM TWO.**

Should any sentence, section, subsection or provision of this Resolution or application thereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the Zoning Ordinance of Madison County, as amended, as a whole nor any part thereof that is not specifically declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.

**ITEM THREE.**

This amendment of the Zoning Ordinance of Madison County, Georgia, shall take effect and shall be enforced from and after the date of its adoption, the public welfare demanding it.
