

**RESOLUTION AMENDING THE STORM WATER ORDINANCE
OF MADISON COUNTY, GEORGIA**

For the purpose of promoting the health, safety, and general welfare of the present and future inhabitants of Madison County and to further the purposes of the Madison County Storm Water Ordinance as set forth therein, the Board of Commissioners of Madison County does hereby ordain and enact into law the following changes to the Storm Water Ordinance.

ITEM ONE.

Section 5.3 shall be added to read:

Section 5.3 – Fencing

All detention and retention ponds shall be enclosed by a 4' chain-link fence.

ITEM TWO.

This amendment of the Storm Water Ordinance of Madison County, Georgia, shall take effect and shall be enforced from and after the date of its adoption, the public welfare demanding it.
