

RESOLUTION AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE  
OF MADISON COUNTY, GEORGIA

For the purpose of promoting the health, safety, and general welfare of the present and future inhabitants of Madison County and to further the purposes of the Madison County Zoning Ordinance as set forth therein, the Board of Commissioners of Madison County does hereby ordain and enact into law the following changes to the Zoning Ordinance.

These items listed below are to be added to the following;

**ARTICLE III: DEFINITION OF TERMS**

**CARPORT:** A two sided or open sided structure used for storing an automobile.

**LEAN -TO:** A three sided structure with slanted roof, generally used for storing wood, farm animals, or farm tools. This can be attached to another structure or stand alone. To include farm machinery, hey, and ect.

**POLE BARN:** It uses large poles or posts buried in the ground or on a slab to provide the vertical structural support and can have girts to provide horizontal support. A Pole barn can be open or three sides closed. They are usually used to house farm animals, to store farm machinery and supplies.

These structures will be exempt for requiring a building permit.

The provisions of this resolution shall be effective upon approval by the Madison County Board of Commissioners.
