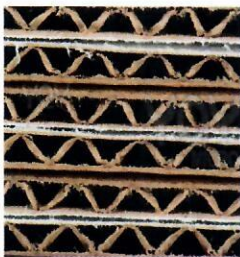

 <p>Glass</p>	<p>All glass containers – Clear, green and brown</p>	<p>Please rinse containers. Do not break</p>	<p>No drinking glasses, window glass, Pyrex dishes, Ceramics, mirrors or other types glass</p>
 <p>Aluminum</p>	<p>Aluminum beverage cans</p>	<p>Empty and rinse (can also be flattened)</p>	<p>No pie plates, aluminum foil</p>
<p>Newspaper, Magazines, Mixed paper, brown paper grocery bags</p> 	<p>Clean, dry newspapers and their inserts, telephone books, junk mail, magazines, envelopes, folders, posters, office paper, boxboard (cereal boxes, soft drink cartons, etc)</p>	<p>Keep clean and dry – may be bundled or loose – place in recycle bins in our Drive Thru Recycle Center</p>	<p>No spiral bound papers or plastic coated paper, waxed paper, wet, weathered or sun bleached paper</p>
<p>Plastic Numbers 1 – 5 &amp; 7 <b>NO # 6 (Styrofoam)</b></p> 	<p>Plastic milk, water and juice jugs, soda bottles, shampoo, detergent, bleach and soap bottles</p>	<p>Empty &amp; rinse; remove lids  Type of plastic is marked on the bottom in the recycling symbol</p>	<p>No motor oil containers. No Styrofoam cups/plates. No rigid (hard) plastics</p>
 <p>Corrugated cardboard</p>	<p>Clean, dry corrugated cardboard (shipping and appliance boxes)</p>	<p>Keep clean and dry. Break down boxes and place in recycle bins in our Drive Thru Recycle Center</p>	<p>Wax coated boxes, detergent boxes, aseptic packaging (milk or juice cartons) or plastic lined boxes</p>
 <p>Steel or “tin” cans</p>	<p>Steel or “tin” food cans</p>	<p>Empty and rinse</p>	<p>No farm chemical containers or cans that contain aluminum</p>
 <p>Scrap Metal/“White Goods”</p>	<p>Refrigerators, stoves, freezers, lawnmowers</p>	<p>See attendant for disposal instructions</p>	<p>Burn barrels</p>
 <p>Tires</p>	<p><b>**FEES APPLY / Vehicle Tires</b></p>	<p>See attendant for current fees</p>	<p>Burned tires, heavy equipment tires</p>
 <p>Motor    Cooking    Filters</p>	<p>Oil &amp; Filters from cars or trucks only  And Cooking Oil</p>	<p>See attendant for disposal</p>	<p>No gasoline, antifreeze, transmission fluid, solvents, hydraulic fluid</p>
 <p>Batteries</p>	<p>Car or truck batteries and Household batteries</p>	<p>See attendant for disposal</p>	
 <p>Electronics</p>	<p>Computers, Printers, Telephones, Radios</p>	<p>Recycling Center</p>	<p><b>NO TV's or Monitors accepted!</b></p>
	<p>Ink Jet Cartridges, Laser Printer Cartridges, Cell Phone &amp; Light Bulbs (CFL bulbs only)</p>	<p>Place in appropriate bins in Recycling Center</p>	<p><b>NO BROKEN Bulbs!</b></p>
